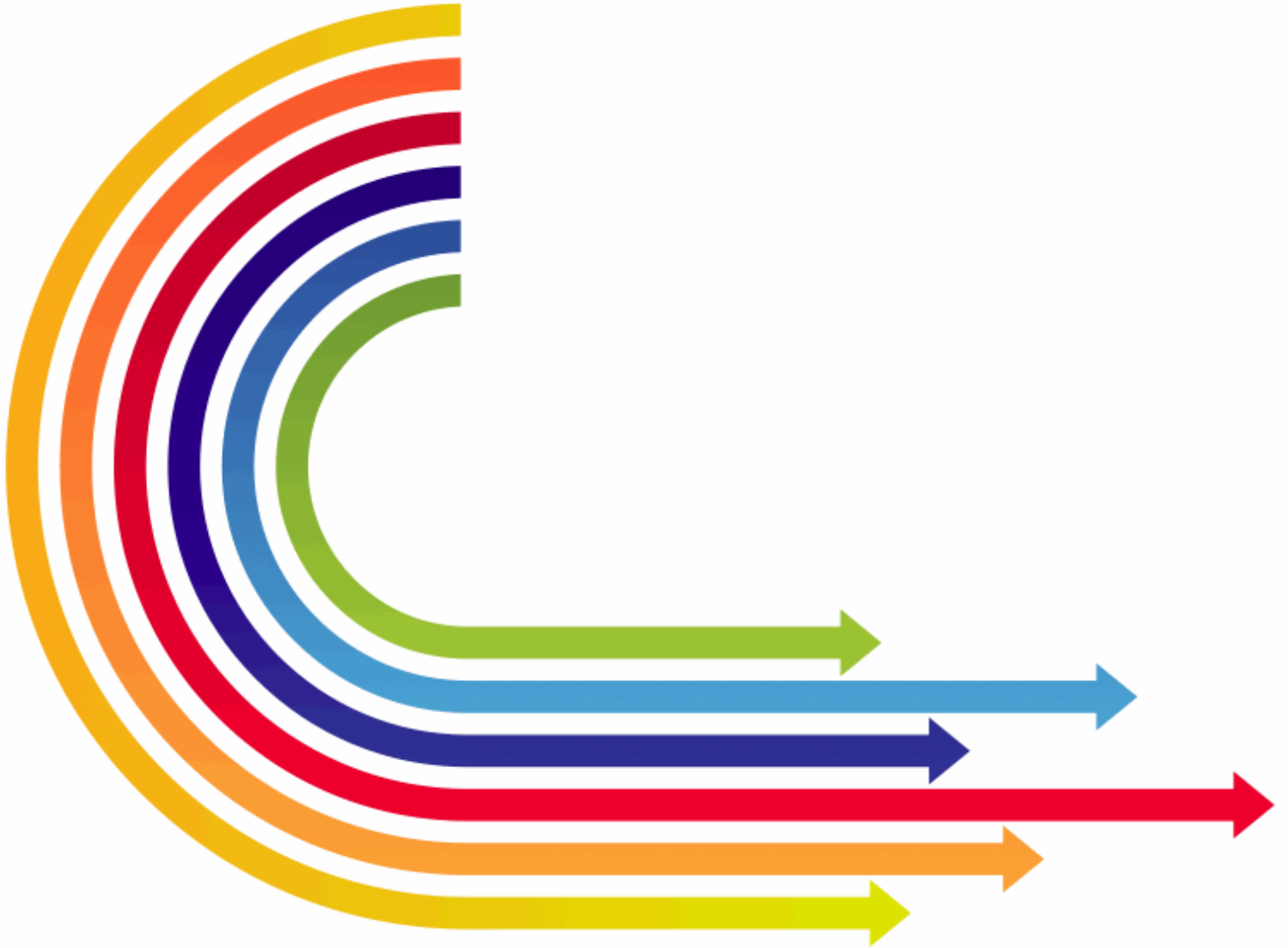

# 1 Introduction

This standard was developed by the member organisations of the Digital Data Exchange, LLC (DDEX) and provides a correction to all choreography standards mentioned below.

## 2 Applicable Standards

This Standard provided a correction to the following standards:

- ERN Choreography Standard, Version 1.2 (which is herewith updated to version 1.2.1);
- DSR Choreography Standard, Version 1.0 (which is herewith updated to version 1.0.1);
- Choreography for the Transfer of Catalogues between Rights Holders of Sound Recordings and other such Rights Holders, Version 1.0 (which is herewith updated to version 1.0.1); and
- Music Licensing Company Message Suite and Choreography Standard, Version 1.0 (which is herewith updated to version 1.0.1).

## 3 Corrections

### 3.1 SFTP

In all of the standards listed in Clause 2 of this Corrigendum, the term “FTP” shall be replaced with “**FTP/SFTP**” throughout, except for the following instances:

- Where the term “FTP” is being defined;
- Where the string “FTP” is part of a longer word (e.g. in “FtpMessageHeader”);
- In clause headings; and
- Where FTP and SFTP are already mentioned alongside each other.

In addition, the following sentence shall be added to the end of the clause or sub-clause introducing the protocol to exchange information via FTP:

*For the avoidance of doubt, this standard supports exchanging information via FTP and/or SFTP. It is for the message sender and message recipient to agree the specific protocol to be used.*

## 3.2 Manifest File Name

In the Batched FTP Profile defined in the ERN Choreography Standard, version 1.2, the first paragraph in Clause 8.3.1 shall be changed to the following:

*The file name of the ManifestMessage for each Batch shall be the string “BatchComplete\_” followed by the BatchId (as defined above) and the .xml file extension. The same file name applied to the zero-byte semaphore discussed in Clause 8.3.1.*

The informative sample in Clause 8.3.5 shall be adapted accordingly by replacing the batch file *Manifest\_20100310130322000.xml* with *BatchComplete\_20100310130322000.xml*.

## 3.3 Message Exchange Protocol

In the Batched FTP Profile defined in the ERN Choreography Standard, version 1.2, a new Clause 8.4 shall be added:

### *8.4 Alternative Protocols*

*On bilateral agreements between Message Sender and Message Recipient it is also possible to use different message exchange protocols as long as they lead to the exact same server organisation with the exact same file names as defined elsewhere in Clause 8 of this standard.*
