

Territorial Scope of a Deal

DDEX messages contain data that can vary between different territories. The band "Suede" is, for instance called "The London Suede" in the US. More critically for many applications is that music ownership may be different between different territories. All of this information is provided in the `ReleaseList`, `ResourceList`, `WorkList` and, where available, `PartyList` sections of the DDEX messages.

It is also quite common that the terms and conditions under which a `Release` may be made available differs from territory to territory. This information is provided, in the `NewReleaseMessage` in the `DealList` section. It is the data in this `Deal` section that is the **only source for information pertaining to the commercial relationship between the message sender and message recipient.**

The information contained in the `ReleaseList`, `ResourceList`, `WorkList` and `PartyList` sections is solely data describing the various elements of the `Release`.
