

Time stamp for data accuracy

All DDEX standards contain a time stamp of the message creation (the `MessageCreatedDateTime` tag in the `MessageHeader`). They do **not** contain a separate tag for the date/time when the data in the message is deemed to be current.

A recipient is therefore required to take the date and time in the `MessageCreatedDateTime` to also be the date and time when the data has been current and, to the best of the knowledge of the message sender, accurate.

As a consequence, message senders are required to ensure, to the best of their ability, that the data placed in a message is current and accurate at the moment the data is being put into a DDEX message.
